

## A Note from the Director

-For many, the title *West Side Story* evokes familiar sounds of the snapping street gangs and the enthusiastic tunes of "America" reminiscent of the 1961 film. After its Broadway debut in 1957, the show quickly received critical acclaim. Over 60 years later, this show remains relevant to today's audiences. This show centers around two rival street gangs in New York City in the late 1950s. The Jets, natives to the streets of New York, and the Sharks, a recently emigrated group from Puerto Rico, fight over who runs the surrounding territory. Maria sends Tony to stop it, hoping it can end the violence. It goes terribly wrong, and before the lovers know what's happened, tragedy strikes and doesn't stop until the climactic and heartbreaking ending.




