### **Note from the Artistic Lead**

It's time to build a Prom! This fall, ISM has worked so hard since the beginning of the school year to make this production of "The Prom" come to life. There are over 100 people involved with this production, and all of them have put in so much effort, and you can tell it paid off!

"The Prom" is a story about love, acceptance, and finding joy while facing the greatest adversities. A relatively new musical, The Prom came to Broadway in 2018 with Netflix producing a movie version of the musical in 2020.

Based on a true story, "The Prom" shares the real narrative of Constance McMillen (portrayed by Emma Nolan in the musical), a senior at Itawamba Agrcultural High School in Mississippi. With plans to bring her girlfriend to prom and to wear a tuxedo, Constance received immediate backlash from the community and school district, who banned her from attending prom. After suing the school district with the ACLU, the school board allowed her to attend prom, but organized a secret prom for the rest of the students. McMillen's story was made public on social media, and many celebrities, such as Green Day and Lance Bass, showed their support for McMillen to help her and her girlfriend attend a real prom without discrimination.

It is an honor to be able to share this story with the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and the surrounding communities. So much of theater is telling stories that need to be told, sharing accounts of narratives that members of the audience may not hear anywhere else, and above all, spreading awareness on important topics through entertainment. The experiences that Constance and her character Emma have in the show happen to LGBTQ+ youth around the world every day. If we can spread a message of acceptance and awareness of others' experiences, then we have worked to be just a small part on the long road to equality for all communities.

Illini Student Musicals is an organization full of members whose commitment to each production overflows with respect for each other, for the stories we tell, and the messages we choose to convey. I am so proud of my fellow organization members and the determination they bring to each rehearsal space to give this show the effort it deserves. Heading into my senior year, I never could have imagined the heights we have reached with understanding of this production, the LGBTQ+ community, and acceptance. Whether you have been a part of ISM for one semester or seven, you each have shown time and time again that you can handle each story with grace. I am so unbelievably excited to see each member of this organization shine this weekend and beyond.

Thank you all for supporting this organization, our spectacular members, and our ability to produce musical theatre at the University of Illinois. Sit back, relax, and enjoy "The Prom!"
