

#### Note from the Director

Footloose is a 1998 musical based off of the 1984 movie of the same name. Though the movie is not a musical, the three songs that were written for the film (Holding out for a Hero, Let's Hear it for the Boy, and Footloose) are all songs that I have been dancing to since I can remember. When selecting a show, I wanted to choose something that was upbeat, dance heavy, and had iconic songs. Footloose seemed like the perfect fit.
